

The Hospital Incident Command System Train the Trainer Course (HICSTTT) is a 16 hour class on the principles of incident command applied to the hospital environment. Students must have completed IS 100, 200 and 700 prior to taking the course as the HICS TTT course builds upon the ICS principles taught in those 3 courses. The course includes interactive discussion on more than 12 different topics including NIMS compliance activities for hospitals, the Incident Management Team, Implementation of HICS in rural and small hospitals, and educational strategies. Also included is in depth presentations on the various tools now part of the HICS. These include the revised Job Action Sheets, the new Incident Planning Guides and Response Guides, and 9 new educational modules. Also discussed are the 20 forms now included with HICS. The course concludes with students assigned a command role and going through the 4 phases of a response to an emergent situation using all of the tools that had been discussed earlier as part of the class. Successful students receive a completion certificate from the Center for HICS Education and Training. Faculty for the course are from the HICS Center and were involved in the original development of the new HICS in 2006.
