



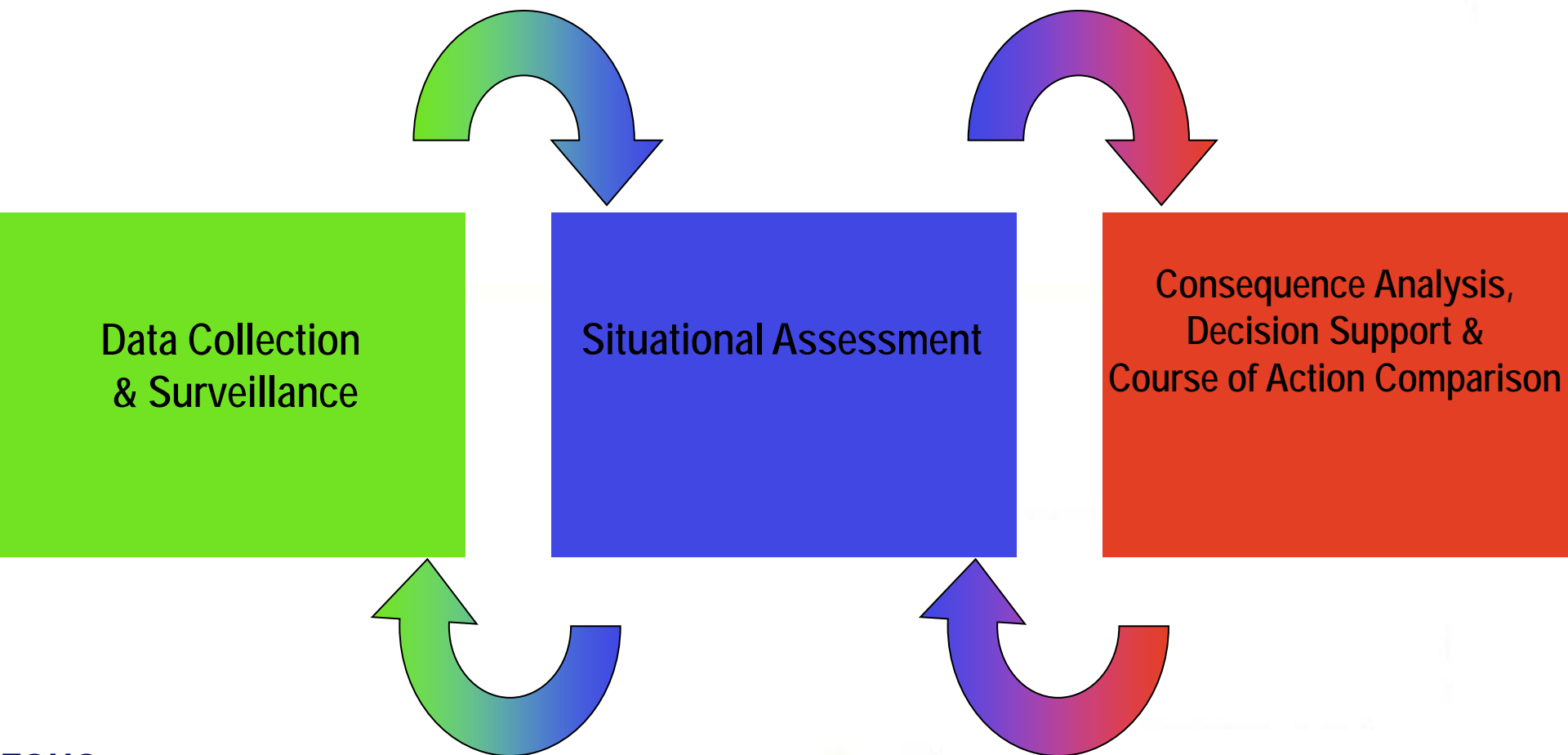

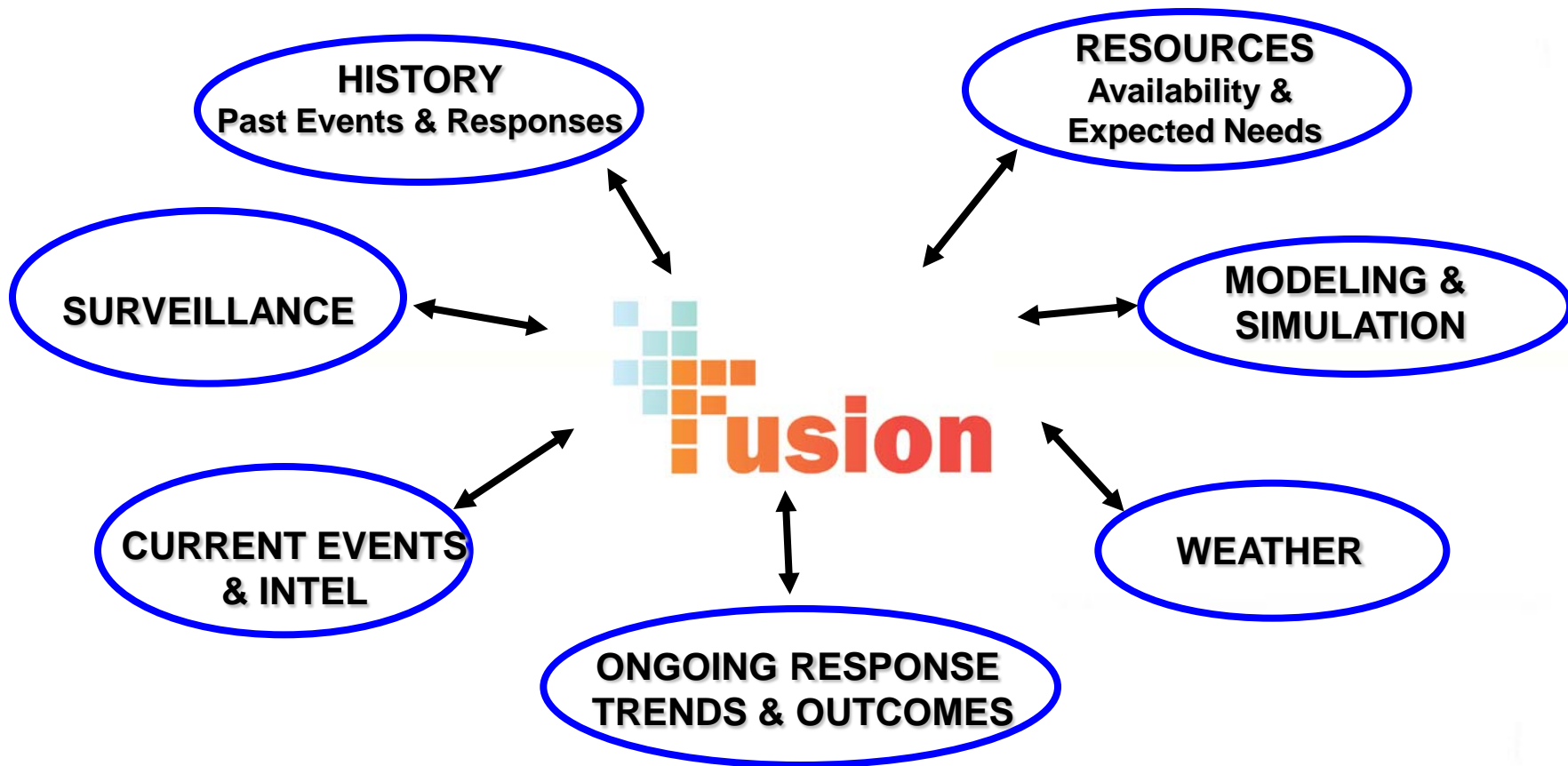


The ASPR Fusion Cell provides analytical decision support for federal, state and local public health, medical and human services agencies and departments during all hazard events.
